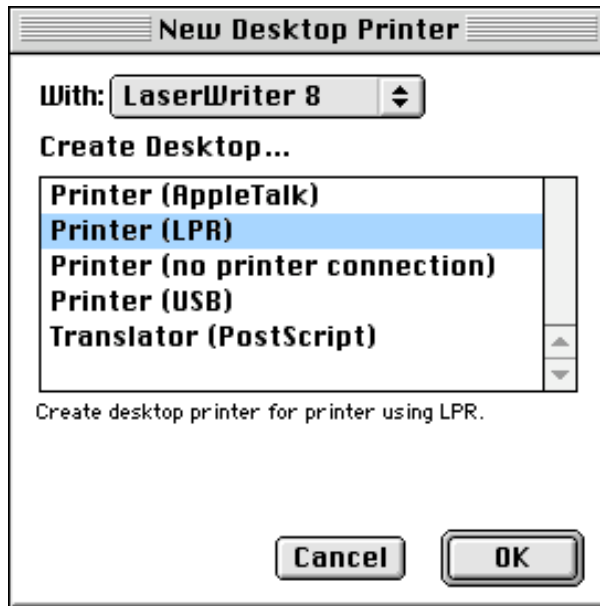


## CREATING AN IP PRINTER IN OS 9

1. In the Applications (Mac OS 9) folder, you will find a Utilities folder, double click on it. Within this folder double click on the Desktop Printer Utility.



2. Click on Printer (LPR) then click OK

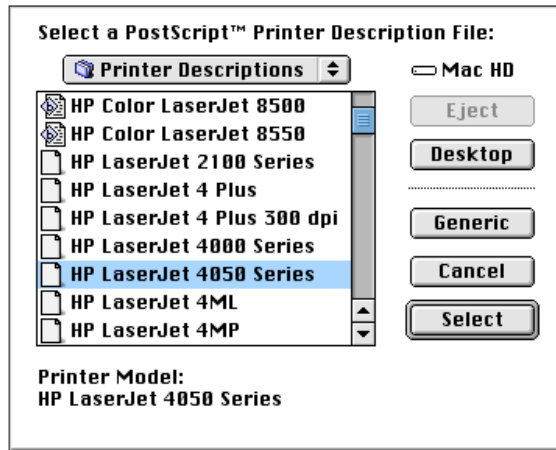


3. Click on Change... for the Printer Description file and find the type of printer you are setting up.



**Note** \*\*\*If you don't see the exact printer on the list, you must install the software for the printer you are trying to set up or copy this printer description file from another working location and put it in the Printer Descriptions folder in the Extensions folder.\*\*\*

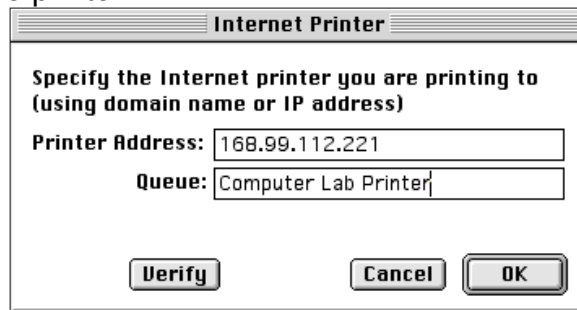
4. Find your printer and click Select.



5. Click on Change... for the LPR Printer Selection.

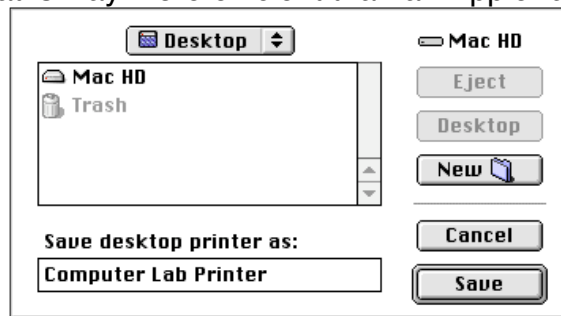


6. Type in the IP # for the printer you are selecting. Make sure the printer is using a static IP and that has been set up in the printer.



7. Click the Create button to create the desktop printer -----> **Create...**

8. Name the Desktop Printer something friendly so you can identify with it. Click Save.. You now have an IP printer that is way more efficient than an AppleTalk one.



9. On your desktop should be your printer. :-)
